

## 2020

Given the high temperatures in August, varieties such as Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara developed well, leading to structured, fine, and elegant rosè wines.

## 2019

Regardless of a very rainy and chilly May, the ripening of Corvina, Rndinella and Molinara benefitted from well-balanced temperature ranges between day and night in summer. Thus, the rosè wines come with an excellent alcohol balance, crispness, and sapidity featured by flawless aromatic assets.

## 2018

2018 is a vintage that witnessed warm temperatures as early as April, accelerating budding and flowering and leading to a considerable quantity of bunches. The harvesting started 8-10 days earlier than in 2017, 2016, and 2015, giving us an outstanding vintage, with +20 percent compared to 2017.

The early varieties Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara show distinct aromaticity and great harmony. In addition, the Corvina grape benefitted from the day/night temperature range, which helped to produce fruity, expressive, intense, and crispy wines.
